REST FOR OUR SOULS ^{© 2010} by Ken Sumrall

The children of Israel were given the land of Canaan and commanded by the Lord to go over and take it. Joshua finally did. For years the Church has sung songs about crossing over to Canaan, meaning dying and going to Heaven. BUT CANAAN HAS NEVER REPRESENTED HEAVEN. The book of Hebrews reviews Israel's journey to Canaan, wandering through the wilderness for forty years before the children of those who left Egypt for Canaan died because of unbelief and their children entered in. They surely did not go to heaven but to a land of REST. We as believers are promised this rest is still available. Hear the Word of the Lord: The highest level of faith is rest or complete trust in the Lord. The writer of Hebrews promised:

"Therefore, since the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us be careful that none of you be found to have fallen short of it. For we also have had the gospel preached to us, just as they did; but the message they heard was of no value to them, because those who heard did not combine it with faith. Now we who have believed enter that rest, just as God has said, and I repeat: There Remains a Rest to the People of God."

HINDRANCES TO REST ARE:

1. **Anxiety:** Paul tells us in Phillipians 4:6-7

"Do not (worry) be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
Jesus promises in Matthew 11: 28-30:

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

The Lord never became anxious about anything. In fact, he was never shown to be in a hurry. He walked, not ran, to work his miracles. Yoking up with him means He carries most of the load which makes our burdens light. So let's not be anxious about the oil spill or about the economy or worry about money or jobs. God will take care of us, making all things turn out for good. He said in His sermon on the Mount:

"Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes? Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life? And why do you worry about clothes? See how the lilies of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. (Mathew 6: 25-34)

2. **Unbelief and Hardness of Heart Hinders Rest** (Hebrews 3: 7-12)

So, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion, during the time of testing in the desert, where your fathers tested and tried me and for forty years saw what I did. That is why I was angry with that generation, and I said, 'Their hearts are always going astray, and they have not known my ways.' So I declared on oath in my anger, 'They shall never enter my rest.' See to it, brothers, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness."

3. **Fretting or Murmuring Hinders Rest.** John Wesley said: "I would no sooner fret than I would curse." God became so angry with the murmuring of the children of Israel that He swore they would not enter the land of rest. We can trust or fret but not both. Fretting is a sin. (Psalms 37:1-14)

Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of those who do wrong; for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away. Trust in the LORD and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun. Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret — it leads only to evil.

Paul summed up what I am saying by telling the Phillipians:

"...for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances." He said to the Hebrews: ... be content with what you have. Jesus said: "Come unto me all you who are weary and heavy laden and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn of me ; For I am meek and lowly in heart and you shall find rest to your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."





Dear Brother Ken, I got to thinking about the time we spent at Liberty and how it was one of those life-changing experiences. I began to go over all the memories of Liberty, and how I wound up there. Here is my story of how I came to Liberty.

I had received the Baptism in the Holy Spirit on Good Friday, April 9, 1971 in Beaumont, Texas. For the next year or so it was like being on a "high" that was the by-product of the joy of the Lord...literally intoxicating, but by the Spirit.

Within a month during prayer I felt a particularly heavy anointing, and the presence of the Lord. From that time in prayer I felt I was called into the ministry. I didn't tell anyone, but for the next several years, through the laying on of hands, prophecies, and other confirmations, the Lord verified what He had told me in that prayer time.

In July of '71, several of us in the church made a trip to Jackson, Mississippi, to another Full Gospel Businessmen's convention. It was there that I met you. During one of your teaching sessions you spoke of Liberty Bible College, and when you did, immediately I felt that it was God's will for me to go to Liberty.

I was working for Exxon Oil Company at the time, and I didn't feel like I should just up and leave. But a miracle happened. Exxon Oil had been drilling oil wells in Jay, Florida 15 years prior to '71 and they capped them. Then they decided to build a gas plant in Jay, and uncap all those wells they had drilled earlier to supply the gas plant.. I had been working in one of the largest gas plants in south La., and before long the plant was buzzing with excitement about this new gas plant coming online in Jay. I found out that Liberty was in Pensacola about 50 miles south of Jay. I began to pray about being transferred to Jay, but with the ultimate goal of going to school at Liberty. I was so concerned about the will of God. Although things had transpired that left little doubt about God's will, I still sought the Lord about the situation. During prayer one day I prayed this prayer: "Okay Father, I am not going to ask to go to Jay, but if they ask me to go, I will take that as You opening the door for me to transfer to Florida." Two days later the head superintendant from Lafayette, made a trip to the Centerville plant. I saw him walking towards me and as we met he extended his hand to me and asked; "how would you like to go to Jay, Florida, Mike?" I could hardly contain myself, but I managed to conceal my excitement and reply with a [controlled], "yes sir, that would be great!"

That was probably September, or October of '71. By December I was on my way to Jay. I made it to Pensacola on Saturday. I had planned on taking in the service at Liberty on Sunday. Some way I met Brother Ken and had an opportunity to share some of what had been happening to me during the year. He invited me to stay at his home until I had to report to

the plant in Jay...so I did. I was immediately struck by the excitement; the power of God, and the anointing that permeated Liberty and I knew I was in the perfect will of God to be there.

After reporting to work at the plant in Jay, I let the superintendant know that I planned on going to Bible college at Liberty in Pensacola, and they assured me it would be no problem, that they would arrange my schedule to be able to start school. January came and went; February..March..April...and I asked again about my schedule and again they told me they would see to it I would start school. Finally, with no change in my schedule, I decided to start school winter quarter of '72. I quit Exxon in October, and within a month I was enrolled in Bible college at Liberty, and thus began the highlight of my life. Liberty was a place of academics, but more than that...MUCH more than that- home; home with tons of brothers and sisters, moms and dads, grandmothers and grandfathers and heading it all up...Papa Sumrall. I had never heard such preaching except during the convention in July of '71 in Jackson, Ms. The power of the vision being carried out by Papa Ken and the leadership just swept the entire ministry along to bring glory and honor to the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

It was easy to grow in prayer, and praise, and worship, and fellowship. I remember going into a prayer room beside the stage and praying with a roomful of men who were packed so tightly there wasn't enough room for one more person. The ladies prayed in a room on the other side of the stage, and when it came time for the service to begin all heaven broke loose.

The love of God was ..palpable. It was impossible to be any part of Liberty under Papa Ken and not know, and grow in the love of God- enduring love that to this day has its own special place in each of our hearts who were a part of it. Moms and pops like Ma and Pa Beavers, Ma and Pa Kraner and scores of others, many of whom have been home with their Christ for sometime now, part of the "great cloud of witnesses".

My dear Papa..I know that you know that I love you. However, let it be told you again, and again, and again. You showed me the love of God, and I return to you the love of God. Your legacy is contemporary with you when most men's legacy follows them. There have been those I have crossed paths with in my life that I walk away with this reality...I'll never be the same. Meeting you, more than any other, draws that reality out of me. My heart is still with you dear Papa. Loving Him, Mike Burgess

A MIGHTY WEAPON

(Note: This article has been sent in a former Chit-Chat, but we need it more now than ever. With the oil spill in the Gulf, the deep financial recession and the corruption of our political leaders, which is a symbol of our national need for repentance for immorality. My family needs your prayer and fasting for healing. Please take this word seriously!)

None of us like war, but believe me, we are in one. Actually, the Scriptures from beginning to end are sixty six books of warfare. Jesus conquered Satan and settled his destiny at Calvary, but he is not in Hell yet, but roams the earth to seek those he can devour. (1 Peter 5:8) The fact is that he knows his time is short, so he is attempting to harm God's people or thwart their efforts to build God's Kingdom any way he can.

"We use God's mighty weapons, not mere worldly weapons to knock down the Devil's strongholds." 2 Cor 10:3 (NLT)
"We are not fighting against people made up of flesh and blood, but against unseen evil forces." (Ephesians 6:12 -paraphrased by Ken Sumrall)

Fasting with prayer is a mighty weapon to conquer Satan's forces who set out to discourage and defeat God's people. It is also an effective way to intercede for a nation. Not long ago, a day was set aside to pray at noon all over our nation. I am sure God was pleased that some came together for the occasion; thank God for any effort to seek the Lord for His blessings on our nation. But isn't it time for more desperate prayers that last more than thirty minutes to an hour one day a year? I was recently with a group of believers who are in a financial crisis. After discussing strategies and possibilities for a long time, we decided we need to fast and pray about the situation. Jesus said: "This kind of faith does not come but by prayer and fasting." (Matt. 17:21) He was speaking to defeated disciples who had failed to have faith to help an epileptic lad. After Jesus rebuked them for their little faith, he healed the boy instantly. The disciples asked: "Why could we not heal the boy?" Jesus answered that it takes more than normal prayer for desperate situations. They require fasting and prayer. Esther had discovered power of fasting and thereby saved the Jewish people from extinction. (Esther 4) The Liberty Church in Pensacola experienced miracles many times over the years as they saw fasting and prayer overcome impossible situations.

There is a cultural and moral war going on in our nation. The conservatives and the liberals use all kinds of political rhetoric to persuade the voters of our nation to vote for or against a candidate according to their ideological beliefs. I understand this kind of fighting and my flesh gets hot with anger over the way our legislatures vote on issues and even more so over Judges who make laws rather than interpret them. I do believe we should vote for Bible-believing candidates. But only God can tenderize hearts and change the moral climate of our nation. Surely my words of anger will not promote righteousness. (James 1) Nor will yours. The real battle is in the heavens with unseen forces. It will take more than normal prayers and ideological speeches to defeat these forces.

God says He has given us mighty weapons which will break down Satan's strongholds. I could mention several, but I am honing in on Fasting Prayer. Some may ask: What are the main reasons for fasting? Let me list a few without laboring them:

- (1) Fasting disciplines my soul and body and causes my inner man to rise up and take dominion over my flesh. (Ps 35:13; 69:10). If anyone reading this has difficulty giving up smoking, I challenge you to fast at least three days, eating nothing and drinking only water. I know this may be hard for some of you, but IT WORKS! The same is true with any lust of the flesh. Pornographic fantasies can also be conquered with fasting and prayer. (Insert: 1 Chron. 7:14 speaks of humbling ourselves. There is no more effective way to bring humility than with fasting. David said: *"I humbled my soul with fasting."* (Ps. 35:13)
- (2) Fasting gives us victory in times of crisis. Esther 4 is an example.
- (3) Fasting sets missionaries on the fields to minister the gospel. Paul and Barnabas were sent out after fasting and prayer confirmed their callings. (Acts 13:1-3)
- (4) We see things from God's perspective when we fast. (Isaiah 58) When I fast, I see my own sins (Isaiah 6:1-6): I see the world from God's viewpoint; I see the needs of the poor; I see Calvary love, God's grace, and hear from God more easily when I fast for a season.
- (5) Fasting turns a nation or city away from God's wrath. (Jonah 3:5-10)
- (6) Fasting gives power for ministry. (Luke 4)

Kinds of Fasting:

- (1) Jesus and Moses fasted 40 days without food or water. That kind of fast would of necessity be supernatural. A person cannot live without water 40 days.
 - (2) Daniel went on a partial fast. (Daniel 9) He drank water, juices and may have eaten raw vegetables.
 - (3) The normal fast is going without any foods and drinking only water for three days and three nights. (Esther 4)
- My purpose in writing this message is to stir our hearts to agree with our believing friends to fast and pray more, especially when there is an urgent need for the Lord to move in power for healings, for serious financial need, for a national revival of righteousness, and for any other deeply felt legitimate need we have.

The news media were there, but not one word of this man's appearance ever appeared on TV or in print, even though he completely dominated the scene.

This is a Time for Courage April 15, 2009

Ladies and gentlemen, "We are gathered here today on the plains of West Texas in common purpose. We are here to remind our government that this is our country, We the People are still in charge, and our government is still our servant and not our master. "Our Nation's founding document is The Declaration of Independence. It tells us that our rights come from God and not from a small group of elite men and women.

"Our Constitution starts with the words "We the People." Our Constitution was written for ordinary Americans like you and me. Our Constitution protects us from our government and from the politicians. "Our President has complained that our Constitution gives ordinary people too much protection. He has ridiculed us for the high value we place on our Bibles, our guns, our personal property, and our liberty. He tells us we do not deserve to keep the money we have earned. We are told freedom has not worked. Personal responsibility, free enterprise, and Liberty have not been effective. Our government will now make more of our decisions for us. Going to see the work elephants this afternoon. And Ann wants to ride one. Ann and I leave here Monday night fly to Rome Italy for 4 days and then on to our Med.
